G20 Investment and Infrastructure Working Group (IIWG) meeting was held in Sanya, China on December 16, 2015, which was the first IIWG meeting since China assumed the G20 Presidency on December 1, 2015. The meeting was co-chaired by delegates from Germany, Indonesia and Mexico. On behalf of the Presidency, representative of the MOF China introduced the agenda, proposed deliverables and work plan of IIWG in 2016. Participants reached a broad agreement on the work plan, and 3 pillars were identified as the priorities of 2016 IIWG agenda: 1) encouraging Multilateral Development Banks to advance infrastructure investment by taking joint actions; 2) promoting global infrastructure connectivity; 3) exploring diversified financing approaches and fostering private financing. The 2nd and 3rd IIWG meeting will be held in April in Singapore and in June in Indonesia respectively.

Delegates from G20 member countries, invited guest countries and relevant international organizations attended the meeting.
